Austria and Beyond

There will be a lot of obscure stuff, along with big cities Vienna, Graz, and Innsbruck, as seen in March of 2006. If time allows, Herb may also show some slides of his September 2006 trip to Greece and Turkey.

February 3, 2007

His Kind of Town: Chicago

Stan Genthner will be on hand with a selection of images from around the Chicago area in the 1950s, '60s, and early '70s, highlighting the famous "L" system, the Illinois Central suburban lines, and the Chicago, South Shore & South Bend interurban line.

March 3, 2007

Philadelphia in the 1980s, Part II

Brad Clarke, BSRA President, will return with a follow-up selection of vintage slides from his large Philadelphia-area collection. This year, Brad will examine the West Philadelphia subway-surface routes as they once were; and as time permits, other elements of the system such as the High-Speed (Rapid Transit) lines, the Red Arrow Lines, and PTC's trackless trolley network.

April 7, 2007

A View From Inside the Cab

Glen L. Rowe, a veteran New York subway motorman and long-standing officer of the Urban Transit Club, will exhibit a variety of unusual, "inside" views that he has accumulated through his 23+ years on the job. Included are images taken inside the plethora of yards and shops around the system, new car deliveries, old car disposal, and some of the NYCTA's rarely seen work equipment. Glenn will also touch upon his large collection of slides of New York City GMC "Fishbowl" buses, Metro-North commuter trains and various other topics from the New York area.

May 5, 2007

Traction & Rail 2006

Eric Oszustowicz returns with his annual show portraying his recent travels. This year he will focus on: commuter/intercity rail in New Zealand, plus trackless trolleys and diesel and electric freight rail lines there; commuter/intercity rail in Scotland (EdinburghGlasgow, etc.), plus the subway and some bus transport in Glasgow; commuter and intercity rail plus light rail and bus transport in Dublin, Ireland; an update of freight and passenger rail through the Canadian Rockies, on the CN from Vancouver to Edmonton, and on the CP from Vancouver through Banff; a brief update on trackless trolley operations in Seattle; and finally (of course) some New York area subjects, too.

Video and slide current event materials are presented following the scheduled entertainment when time permits. Current event materials should be queued with the Entertainment Chairman prior to the start of the meeting. Video presentations are limited to 10 minutes per person; slides are limited to 35 per person.
